May M. Mahon and Dennis M. Mahon her husband by our promissory note of  
such date herewith, payable six months after date to Noah E. Cromer or order for  
the sum of seventy seven dollars and fifty cents with interest from date at the  
rate of six per cent per annum stand indebted unto the said Noah E. Crom-  
mer, in the sum of money in said promissory note recited and for the pur-  
pose of securing the payment of the said promissory note at the maturity  
thereof together with all interest that may accrue thereon according to the terms  
and conditions thereof we the said Lillie May M. Mahon and Dennis M. Ma-  
hon her husband have agreed to execute these presents.

Now therefore in consideration of the above recited premises and in the fur-  
ther consideration of the sum of five dollars to us hand paid at and before  
the execution and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-  
edged we the said Lillie May M. Mahon and Dennis M. Mahon her  
husband do grant and convey unto the said Noah E. Crommer all of  
our undivided rights, title, interest and estate it being an undivided one  
third interest subject to a dower right in and to all that part of a lot or  
portion of ground situate lying and being on the South side of All  
Saints Street in Frederick City, Frederick County, State of Maryland,  
also all those parts of two lots or portions of ground situate lying and  
being on All Saints Street in Frederick City
