Order

No. 7407 Equity

The Petition of M & Creeger trading as J Creeger & Son and Daniel L. Wilhite respectfully represent unto your Honors:-

First, That they are residents of Frederick County, Maryland.

Second

That the said J Creeger and son are creditors of Dorcas Pennell late of Frederick County, deceased, in that they furnished the casket for the burial of said deceased and also furnished other funeral supplies, hucks etc as will appear from their account filed herewith as a part of this petition marked Exhibit No. 1 which said account amounts to the sum of seventy eight dollars and ninety four cent; and that Daniel L. Wilhite is also a creditor of said Dorcas Pennell, deceased, in that he was employed to dig the grave of said deceased, and that the amount of said Bill is four dollars as well be vindicated his account filed herewith as a part hereof marked Exhibit No 2.

Third. That said accounts are due and owing your petitioners and that no part of the same has ever been paid to them.

Fourth.

That they desire to become parties co-plaintiff in these proceedings filed against Emma J. Roblitz, Samuel Pennell et al. to the end that the real estate as named in these proceedings as the property of which the said Dorcas Pennell, died, seized and possessed, may be sold for the claims of your petitioners and the other creditors of said Dorcas Pennell, deceased, as in said Bill of complaint mentioned as fully as if your petitioners had been named as one of the plaintiffs in said Bill of complaint when originally filed.

Wherefore your petitioners pray your Honors:-

1. That your Honors will pass the order of your Honorable Court, directing that your petitioners may be allowed to become parties plaintiff in these proceedings as fully as if your petitioners were originally named in said Bill of complaint as plaintiffs in these proceedings.
2. And for such other and further relief to which your petitioners may be entitled, and as to your Honors will appear right and equitable.
