To the Honorable, the judges of said Court:-

Your orator, who sues as well for himself as for all the other creditors of Townsend Coats, late of Montgomery County, deceased, who will come in and contribute to the expenses of this suit complaining says:-

- 1 That the said Townsend Coats, in his life time indebted unto your Orator in the full and just sum of One hundred and seventy five dollars by his Promissory Note dated on the first day of November 1899, for said sum of money payable unto your orator one year after date with interest from date at the rate of six per cent per annum on which note there is a credit of \$6¹² as of the 2^d day of September 1902 as will fully appear by reference to said note herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 1, which with all the other Exhibits herewith filed so prayed to be taken and considered as parts hereof, and also unto sundry other persons in various sums of money.
- 2, That the said Townsend Coats at the time of his death as hebe of his mentioned was seized and possessed of certain lands lying partly in Frederick and partly in Montgomery Counties, Maryland, also unto that in Frederick County containing 8 Acers 3 rods and 11 perches of land and more fully described in a deed for the same to the said Townsend Coats from McHenry J. Naylor and wife, a certified copy of which is herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 2 and that in Montgomery County containing 6.75 Acers and more fully described in a deed to said Townsend Coats from George H. Wilson and wife, a certified copy of which is herewith filed marked Exhibit No. 3.
3. That the said Townsend Coats being indebted as aforesaid and having real estate both in Frederick and Montgomery County as aforesaid and also having a small amount of personal Estate bequeathed this life in Montgomery County on or about the 29th day of January 1901, intestate, leaving a widow, Belle J Coats, who is and albeit about 36 years of age and now residing in Washington City in the District of Columbia and the following children as his heirs at law viz:-
