Shaff and the Franklin Savings Bank of Frederick a body corporate, commanding them, and each of them to be and appear in this Court on some certain day to be named therein to answer the premises and to abide by and perform such decree as may be passed hereon, and

(2) An order of Publication given notice to the said Anna Young and Frank Young her husband, John S. Shaff and Lucy Shaff, his wife, and Grant Shaff and Lottie Shaff, his wife all of Clinton County in the State of Indiana, and Sarah Shaff, Mary Helvie and Anne L. Helvie, her husband, and <sup>Samuel Shaff</sup> Ross Shaff, his wife, Martha Richardson and A. B. Richardson, her husband and John H. Shaff and Elizabeth Shaff his wife, all of Cass County in the State of Indiana, and all non-residents of Maryland, of the object and substance of this Bill, and warning them to appear in this Court, in person or by Solicitor on or before a certain day to be named therein, to show cause, if any they have, why a decree ought not to pass as prayed
