Deed is recorded Oct. 5 1846.

This Indenture made this fifth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty six - between John Shaff of Clinton County in the State of Indiana of the one part and Daniel Shaff of the County of Frederick in the State of Maryland of the other part whereas Samuel Shaff and Mary E Shaff his wife of Clinton County in the State of Indiana have executed a power of attorney bearing date the second day of June 1846. and have appointed the said John Shaff of the same County and State their true and lawful attorney to sell dispose of and convey all their right, title claim and interest in and to all lands and tenements and hereditaments in the State of Maryland and particularly all the interest of the said Saml Shaff and wife in and to the lands - belonging to the estate of the late Jacob Shaff dec'd reference - being had to the said power of attorney duly recorded on the same day with these presents among the land records of Frederick County will fully appear. Now this Indenture Witnesseth: That the said John Shaff in and by by virtue of the power and authority to him given as aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars current money to him in hand paid by the said Daniel Shaff at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold, released, aliened, conveyed, and confirmed unto the said Daniel Shaff his heirs and assigns, all the right title claim and interest of the said Saml Shaff and Mary E Shaff as heirs at law of Jacob Shaff late of Frederick County dec'd of in and to all those tracts or parcels of land, Situate lying and being in Frederick County, State of Maryland being part of a tract of land called "Frederick" and part of Arroy in "Barbours" which was conveyed by deed bearing date the 17th day of August 1844 and recorded in Liber T. B. No. 1. folio 75th 76 one of the land records of Frederick County aforesaid, containing one hundred and fifty one and a half acres of land except thirteen & one quarter which was on the 3rd day of Feb 1815 conveyed by the said Jacob Shaff to a certain John Long by deed duly recorded in Liber T. S. No 5. folio 58th c one of the land records of the County aforesaid, also another part of the same tracts of land containing five
