This is to give notice to James T. Phelous, Lula Bowman and Edna Shipley (now Edna Behm) non-residents parties to the above entitled cause, of the substance and object of the petition of John C. Walker, filed in said cause on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of September 1903 on behalf of himself and of all other Creditors of William H. Phelous deceased the petition alleges that William H. Phelous, was in his life-time indebted to said petitioner in the sum of \$46.46, which with interest now amounts to the sum of \$57.10 as is shown by an itemized account filed with the petition; that said indebtedness still remains due, owing and unpaid; That Ellen Phelous was appointed by the Orphan Court of Frederick County administratrix of the goods and chattels of William H. Phelous is wholly insufficient for the payment of his debts, The petitioner thus prays that his claim, as well as the claims of all other creditors of William H.
