This Deed made this nineteenth day of March in the year Eighteen hundred and eighty three, by me, Ephraim H. Burkman assignee of Mortgage with interest, whereas, David Tomes having conveyed the hereinafter described tracts of land to Barbara E. Tomes by Mortgage dated on the 29th day of March, A. D. 1879, and recorded in Liber T. G. No 11 folio 276 C one of the Land Records of Frederick County, in order to secure the payment of a certain sum of money named therein, and the interest thereon, at the time and in the manner therein specified; which Mortgage provided that if default should be made in the payment of the said sum of money or the interest thereon at the time and in the manner therein specified, then it should be lawful for the said sum of money or the interest thereon at the time and in the manner therein specified then it should be lawful for the said Barbara E.
