Viz: -

Louisa B. Marshall who married Horton G. Thompson, and who resides at Gaithersburg, Montgomery County, Maryland; Sarah E. Marshall who married Frank Fraly and who died in the year 1897, without leaving issue living at her death, and Cora E. Marshall unmarried, and who resides at Washington Grove, Montgomery County, Md.

That at the time of the death of the said Thomas Marshall, in the month of June 1903, the period fixed for distribution by the terms of said will, there were but two daughters by the second wife surviving, namely - Louisa B. Thompson and Cora E. Marshall who are entitled to have the Corpus of said trust fund of fifteen thousand dollars equally to be divided between them.

6th

That the said sum of fifteen thousand dollars is invested in the five lots or parcels of ground and the rents issuing thereout, situate in the City of Baltimore State of Maryland, and fully described in the deed from George Johnson and Charles H. Ross, Executors, to the said Charles H. Ross, Trustee, in two Certificates of Weekly Deposits in the Frederick Town Savings Institution amounting in the aggregate to 29034

7th

That it is impossible to make an equal division or distribution of said investments between the parties entitled in remainder or reversion without loss or injury, and that it would be to their advantage that the said lots or parcels of ground and investments be sold and the proceeds of sale divided between the parties entitled thereto.

8th

That in making said sale and the execution of said trust said petitioner desires the aid and protection of your Honorable Court therefore for the purpose of executing said trust and making distribution as required by the terms of the will of Ann P. Marshall, deceased prays that the said Thomas Marshall, Elazett Lyle Marshall son of said Thomas Marshall, and the said Louisa B. Thompson and Horton G. Thompson her husband and Cora E. Marshall all of whom reside in Montgomery County, Maryland may answer the matters and things stated and charged in the foregoing petition.

And that a decree may be passed authorizing and empowering the said Charles H. Ross Trustee, to convey to the said Thomas Marshall and Elazett Lyle Marshall, whatever interest or title he may have in the farm situate in Montgomery County, devised to them by the will of the said Ann P. Marshall, and that the said ground rents ^{lots or} parcels of land, situate in the City of Baltimore in the State of Maryland in the State of Maryland, held by the said Charles H. Ross Trustee as a part of the Corpus of the said trust estate may be sold under the order and decree of your Honorable Court as well as the said weekly deposits in the said Frederick Town Savings Institution, and the proceeds of sale of the same, less the costs of these proceedings including Commissions be equally divided among the parties entitled thereto.
