To the Honorable, the Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick's County, sitting as a Court of Equity. The report of Sales of Charles H Rose, trustee under the will of Ann P Marshall, deceased, for the benefit of Thomas Marshall, respectfully shows unto your Honor that in obedience to an order of your Honorable Court, passed in the above Cause on the Seventh day of August in the year Nineteen hundred and three, your trustee has sold at private sale the various lots hereafter described, forming a part of the trust fund in this Cause as follows:-
