

No 6694. Equity.

Real estate will not admit of partition or division among the parties of interest without loss and injury, and that in order to make division of said interest it will be necessary that said real estate be sold and the proceeds thereof divided amongst the parties according to their respective interests. The bill then asks that an order of publication issue against the said non-residents and for such further and other relief as their case may require.

It is therefore, this 23rd day of February in the year A. D. 1897, ordered by the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity that the Plaintiff, by causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper published in said Frederick County once in each for four successive weeks before the 25th day of March A. D. 1897 give notice to the said absent defendants of the object and substance of this Bill, warning them to appear in this Court in person or by Attorney on or before the 10th day of April next to show cause if any they have why a decree ought not to be granted as prayed.
