The Bill further states that the aforesaid real estate

division of said interest it will be necessary that said
real estate be sold, and the proceeds thereof divided
amongst the parties according to their respective interests.
The Bill then asks that an order of publication
issue against the said, non residents, and for such
further and other relief as their case may require.
It is thereupon, this 23rd day of February, in the
A. D. 1897, Ordered by the Circuit Court for Frederick
County, sitting as a Court of Equity, that the said
