or order in the premises: They shall then proceed to sell, having previously given at least three weeks notice of the time, in some newspaper, published in Washington County, Maryland, of the time, place, manner, and terms of sale, which terms shall be as follows. Viz: One third of the purchase money to be paid in hand on the day of sale or the ratification thereof, and the residue in equal payments in one and years from the day of sale with interest thereon from the day of sale, the purchaser to give his or their notes or bonds with a surety, or sureties to be approved by said Trustees for the said deferred payments. And as soon as may be convenient after the making said sale, the Trustees shall report to this Court, upon oath, a full and particular account of their proceedings under this decree, with the name of the purchaser or purchasers, and on the ratification of such sales or sales by this Court, and on the layment of the purchase money, (and not before) the said Trustees by a good and sufficient deed, to be executed and acknowledged agreeably to law, shall convey to the purchaser or purchasers of said property, and to his her or their heirs the property to him, her or them sold, free, clear and discharged of all claims of the parties to this cause, and of any person claiming by, from or under them, and the said Trustees shall bring into this Court, the money arising on such sales, and the Bonds or notes, which may be taken for the same, to be disposed of under the direction of this Court, after deducting therefrom the cost of the suit, and such Commission, to the said Trustees as this Court shall allow, in consideration of the skill, attention and fidelity, wherewith they shall appear to have discharged
