Tyson and Son, obtained a judgment against the said Michael Roberts by confession, before Alfred Ritter, a Justice of the Peace, on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1895, for the sum of Fifty-One Dollars and Ninety-Eight Cents, with interest and costs, as will appear by reference to a Copy of said Judgment filed herewith and "Exhibit B".

That the personal property of the said Michael Roberts, being insufficient for the payment of the debts of him the said Michael Roberts, as heretofore alleged, the real estate heretofore mentioned should be sold under a decree of your Honorable Court and the proceeds applied to the payment of the debts of the said Michael Roberts according to their legal priority.

To the End Wherefore,  
 (1) That the real estate aforesaid may be sold under a decree of your Honorable Court and the proceeds thereof applied to the payment of the debts of the said Michael Roberts according to their legal priority.

(2) That your complainant may have such other and further relief as the nature of his case may require.

May it please your Honor to grant unto your Complainant, the writ of Habeas Corpus in the usual form against the said Mary C. Roberts Administratrix of Michael Roberts deceased, Mary C. Roberts, widow Henry Roberts and Cordelia F. Roberts, his wife, Iowa Damer and George A. Damer, her husband. — Wachtler, and Ethan A. Wachtler, her husband, Doctor R. Wachtler Edward F. Roberts, and Fannie F. Roberts, his wife, Henry Unvorgast and David C. Wiestbauer, partners trading as unvorgast and Wiestbauer, Doctor R. Wachtler, assignee Jacob B. Tyson, Henry B. Tyson, and Nathan S. Tyson, Partners trading as J. Tyson and Son, all of whom are adults and reside in Frederick County, Maryland and against Kate Guesey and Augustus W. Guesey, her husband, adults and residing in Frederick County, Maryland; and to Etzel Wachtler, Iowa Wachtler, Mamie Wachtler and Emma Wachtler, infants, Children of Victoria Wachtler deceased, residing in Frederick County, Maryland, commanding them that each of them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some day certain to be named therein, to answer
