To the honorable the Judges of said Court:  
 The Bill of Complaint of James McPherson of Fredrick  
 County in the State of Maryland, respectfully shews,  
 1. That Edward L. McPherson departed this life on the  
 eighth day of May 1900 intestate, leaving surviving him  
 a widow Alberta S. McPherson and the following children  
 and the following children viz. Mary, now the wife of  
 James Klingluff; Eliza T. McPherson; Helen McPherson and  
 Margaret McPherson, and funds of the real estate described  
 in Exhibits hereinafter exhibited and situated in  
 Fredrick City, in the County, and State aforesaid, and  
 which descended to said children:

2. That the said Edward L. McPherson, and Alberta  
 S. McPherson, being indebted unto the Franklin Savings  
 Bank of Fredrick in the sum of fifteen hundred  
 Dollars, did on the 20th day of November in the  
 year eighteen hundred and eighty nine execute to  
 the said Bank a mortgage conveying certain real  
 estate, alluded to in the preceding paragraph, to said  
 Bank to secure the payment of said indebtedness as  
 will appear by reference to a Certified Copy of said  
 mortgage herewith filed and marked "Exhibit A" and  
 which as well as all other exhibits hereinafter or  
 herewith exhibited, it is prayed may be taken, and  
 treated as a part of this bill, as fully as if  
 it and all of them were herein set large in words  
 and figures set forth:

3. That the said Edward L. McPherson being further indebted  
 unto a certain Christian Weinmann in the sum of  
 one thousand dollars, did together with the said  
 Alberta S. McPherson, his wife convey unto said Weinmann  
 the same real estate by way of mortgage on the  
 tenth day of January in the year eighteen hundred
