The Petition of Edward W. Eichelberger assignee of

his wife respectfully shew unto your honors:
1st That on the 8th day of August A. D. 1890, a
certain J. Graham Johnson, Esq. L. Kemp and
Florence Kemp, his wife did execute, acknowledge
and deliver their deed of Mortgage, conveying
