

No. 7560 Equity.

That at the time of his death the said John E. Snyder was Seized and possessed of two separate but contiguous parcels of land situated, lying and being in Mount Pleasant District in said County, the first parcel consisting of sixteen and one quarter acres and being the same real estate described in the deed from John L. Mattes trustee to the said John E. Snyder, dated Dec 16, in the year 1893, and recorded in Liber J. L. J. No. 5, Folio 476, one of the Land Records of Frederick County Maryland, and the second parcel consisting of fifteen acres, more or less, and being the same real estate as described in the deed from Samuel C. Wilson, Administrator, to John E. Snyder, dated May 8, 1897, and recorded in Liber J. L. J. No. 161, Folio 779, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland Certified Copies of said deeds being herewith filed as part herof and marked respectively "Exhibit A" and "B".

That at the time of his death the said John E. Snyder was indebted unto your Orator on a Promissory Note which he executed in conjunction with his wife Mary or Mary E. Snyder, dated May 5th, in the year 1897 for the sum of Six hundred and fifty dollars on which said Note there are credits evidenced for the sum of twenty dollars and fifty dollars paid thereon leaving yet due and owing to your Orator the sum of Two hundred and ninety dollars of principal of said Note, with interest thereon, all of which is induced by said Promissory Note herewith filed as part herof, and marked "Exhibit C".

That administration upon the personal estate of the said John E. Snyder has been granted unto said Mary E. Snyder as administratrix as well appear by reference to a Copy of the grant of letters to her by the Orphan Court for Frederick County, Maryland filed herewith as a part herof, and marked "Exhibit D".

That the personal estate of said John E. Snyder is greatly insufficient to pay the just debts due by him at the time of his death, including the debts to your Orator, and other creditors of his estate.
