To the Honorable, the Judge of said Court:-  
Your Orator and Oratrix Complaining

Show:-  
I. That Hezekiah Murphy, late of Frederick County,  
did intestate on or about the 11th day of August  
in the year nineteen hundred and three, Seized  
and possessed of a farm situated in Frederick  
County, containing eighty acres, two rooms and three  
square perches of land, more or less, devised in  
a deed from Joseph H., Dick and wife to the said  
Hezekiah Murphy, a certified copy of which is filed  
herewith marked Exhibit No. 1, and which, with all  
other Exhibits herewith filed is prayed to be taken  
as part of this Bill of Complaint as fully as if  
here inserted in words and figures.

2. That said Hezekiah Murphy died unmarried  
and without leaving any children or other legal descendants  
and leaving the following as his heirs at law, viz:-

- 1st. Your Orator John Richard Murphy, a brother.
- 2nd. Your Oratrix Sophia Grubell, a sister, and a widow.
- 3rd. David Murphy, a brother, unmarried.
- 4th. Your Orator Joseph Murphy, a brother, married, and  
whose wife is named Mary Catherine Murphy.
- 5th. Samuel Murphy, a brother, married, and whose wife  
is named - Murphy.
- 6th. The following children of Susan Wilson, who was a sister  
of said Hezekiah Murphy, and who died in his  
lifetime leaving the following children now living:-  
A. Betta Szwartzbaugh, the wife of Charles Szwartzbaugh  
B. Elsie McClellan, the wife of Harry McClellan  
C. Oliver Wilson, who is married and whose wife  
named Minnie Wilson.
