Equity.To the Honorable, the Judge of Said Court:-
The Petition of John H. Carter Trustee for Francis Froughe
a lunatic, respectfully Shows unto your Honor:-

1. That a certain Dr. William D. Froughe was on the
27th day of June in the year 1899 appointed the
Committee or trustee of the person and property of
Francis Froughe, the adjudged lunatic in these
proceedings, by your Honorable Court and duly
qualified and entered upon the discharge of his
duties as such Committee or trustee and so continued
until the time of his death as hereinafter set forth.
2. That the said William D. Froughe Trustee as aforesaid
had a portion of the trust funds belonging to said
trust estate invested in Virginia Certifying Bonds of
of the par value of Seven Thousand Dollars, as
follows:-

Seven registered bonds of the State of Virginia of
the par value of one thousand dollars each, being
Numbered No. 612, 613, 614, 974, 975, 976, and 994,
respectively and each of said bonds being registered
in the name "Dr. William D. Froughe Trustee for Francis
Froughe, Trustee for Francis Froughe, a lunatic, of
Ridgville, Henry County, Va." which said bonds were
placed by said Trustee in the Custody of the
Farmer and Mechanic National Bank of Frederick,
Maryland, for safe keeping, and are still in
the Custody of said Bank.

3. That the said William D. Froughe was the
only brother and next of Kin of the said Francis
Froughe and resided in Henry County in the
State of Virginia, where the said lunatic now
resides and has resided for a number of years
past past.

4. That in the Month of April, 1900, the said William
D. Froughe died intestate as to his personalty in
said Henry County, in the State of Virginia and
upon the application of Major B. Anthony and
Bettie Marten Froughe, daughter and only next
of Kin of the said William D. Froughe, deceased
your Petitioner was by the County Court of said
Henry County, at the July Term, 1900, appointed
