trustee to take care and charge of the property real and personal of the said Francis Froughe, a lunatic, with full power and authority to demand, receive and apply said property and money according to the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia governing such estates, and that your Petitioner has qualified as such trustee by taking the oath required by law and giving bond with the Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland as Surety in the penalty of Ten Thousand Dollars Conditioned according to law. And your Petitioner files herewith marked Exhibit A, a duly certified transcript of the proceedings of said Court showing his appointment and qualification and prays that said transcript may be taken and considered as a part of this petition.

5. That it would be to the interest and advantage of said lunatic that said registered bonds of the State of Virginia should be transferred and returned to your Petitioner's trustee of the said Francis Froughe, lunatic who has been appointed and qualified as such trustee by the County Court of said Henry County aforesaid, in order that the income and proceeds of said bonds may be applied under the direction and control of said Court to the use and support of the said lunatic in the jurisdiction of his domicile and where his other real property is being administered.

6. Therefore your Petitioner prays your Honor to appoint a Committee pro tem to receive said registered bonds from said Bank, to deliver the same to your Petitioner for said bonds, and that your Petitioner may have such other and further relief as the nature of his case may require.
