That the funds belonging to the trust created by said will were subsequently invested in part by said Trustee in Virginia Century Bonds of the par value of Eight Thousand Dollars, as follows:— One of said Bonds No. 346 of the par value of \$5000.00, and three of said Bonds Nos. 927, 928, and 929, of the par value of \$1000.00 each, and all of said Bonds were and are registered in the name of Dr. Wm. D. Brougle, Trustee for Francis Brougle a Legatee, Entailed of Ridgeway Henry Co Va and that said Bonds were placed by said Trustee in the Custody of the Farmers and Mechanics National Bank, of Frederick, Maryland, for safe keeping, and are still in the Custody of said Bank.

4. That the said Wm. D. Brougle recently died intestate, and was at the time of his death a resident of Henry County in the State of Virginia and the said Francis Brougle was and is a resident of said County and State and upon the application of Maria B. Anthony and Bettie Martin Brougle, daughter and only next of kin of the said Wm. D. Brougle, deceased, your Petitioner was by the County Court of said Henry County on the 14th day of May, A. D. 1900, appointed Trustee in law of the said Wm. D. Brougle, deceased under the will of Maria Brougle deceased, for the estate bequeathed by said will in trust for the benefit of the said Francis Brougle, and your Petitioner has qualified as such Trustee by taking the oath required by law and by giving bond with the Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland as Surety in the Sum of \$10,000.00 Conditioned according to law, and which said bond has been duly approved by said Court, and your Petitioner herewith files a duly Certified transcript of the proceedings of said Court, showing his said appointment and qualification and the said bond and the approval thereof by said Court, and prays that said transcript may be taken and considered as part of this petition.

5. That the total amount of the estate that will be held by your Petitioner as trustee under the will of the said Maria Brougle, deceased, will be \$8000.⁰⁰ Eight Thousand Dollars.
