The decree heretofore passed in this case having covered and embraced the whole of the property owned by said Legatee & therefore having included the one fourth interest devised to him by the will of his Mother, but having failed to make provision for the nature of the proceeds of his said one fourth interest as required by Sec. 198 Art. 16 of the Code, it is therefore the 27th of Nov. 1899, as of the 12th day August 1896. Adjudged ordered & decreed that the said Trustee invest the said one-fourth interest separately and apart from the trust fund & hold the same upon the trusts decreed in report to said one-fourth interest, in the will of the said Maria Bougle.
