To the Honorable, the Judge of said Court. -

Your Orator complaining, says: -
1. That the Defendant, Joseph H. Main, by his deed
of Mortgage dated October 1st 1866 and recorded
in Liber J H L C No 4 folio 411, one of the Land
Records of Frederick County conveyed the real estate,
being a lot of ground situated in Knoxville in
said County particularly described in said Mortgage,
to Lewis H. Main to secure the payment of the
promissory note of said defendant for the sum
of one thousand dollars dated October 24th, 1886
and payable at sight to Lewis H. Main, the original
of which said Mortgage and promissory note are
herewith filed and, with all other exhibits herewith
filed prayed to be taken and considered as part
thereof marked Exhibits Nos. 1 and 2.
2. That it was provided by said Mortgage that
if the said Joseph H. Main should pay to the
