 I look at Exhibit "B" correctly describes a portion thereof,
 sold to the County School Commissioners of Frederick
 County which is filed with the Examiner & now look
 at Copy Exhibit "C" now filed with the Examiner,
 which correctly describes a portion thereof sold by
 Henry Trope, Mortgagee, leaving in Exhibit "A" 2 1/2
 acres of land more or less.
