

No. 7670. Equity

Remain Subject to the following express conditions. That if the said Elizabeth F. Harris wife of Solomon Harris shall by way of anticipation, alien, charge, mortgage, or transfer by any mode the income arising from the real estate, then and in that event the above devise and bequest in her behalf shall be forfeited and void; and I then devise and bequest the Double three story brick house, to the children of the said Mr. James S. Carlin by his first wife to be equally divided between them share alike or their heirs, if they severally attain lawful age at the death of the said Elizabeth F. Harris, wife of Solomon Harris. Should the aforesaid Double three story house and lot devised and bequeathed to her for life not be forfeited according to the provisions this will, I then devise and bequest the aforesaid Double three story house and lot to John F. Carlin my son and James S. Carlin my son children, by his first wife, that is John F. Carlin is to receive that portion of the Double house now occupied by Jonathan Staley and I devise and bequest that portion of the Double house now occupied by George H. Harris to the children of son Mr. James S. Carlin by his first wife, share and share alike or their heirs or assigns equally to be divided amongst them if they severally attain at full age." a Certified Copy of which will is herewith filed and marked Exhibit No. 1, to this Bill of Complaint which together with all other exhibits Your petitioner prays may be taken and considered as a fact hereof. A description of the same property of which the said John Carlin died seized and possessed will be found by reference to a certain deed from James Carlin to the said John Carlin bearing date Mich 20 1865, and duly recorded in Liber J. H. L. C. No. 2, folio 429 one of the Land Records for Frederick County, a Certified Copy of which deed is filed herewith and marked exhibit No. 2, to this Bill of Complaint.

And that your Complainant Elizabeth F. Harris accepted the provisions of said Will, and has the Custody and Control of said property devised by the 5th paragraph of said Will designated as the property occupied by Jonathan Staley, from and since the death of the said John Carlin until the present time to alien, charge, mortgage, or transfer the income arising therefrom by way of anticipation, in violation
