They shall first file in the Clerk's office of the Court a bond to the State of Maryland, executed by them with a Surety or Sureties to be approved by the Court or the Clerk thereof, in the penalty of Twenty five hundred dollars conditioned for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in them by that Decree, or which may be reposed in them by any future order or decree in the premises. They shall then upon the payment of the whole of the said purchase money and next before convey to the said purchaser the said several Lots or parcels of land agreed to be sold as aforesaid together with the right of way and easements mentioned in these proceedings free clear and discharged of all claims of the parties to this cause and of any person claiming by force or under them or any of them, by a good and sufficient deed to be executed and acknowledged agreeably to law, and that said Trustee shall bring into this Court the said purchase money to be disbursed of under the direction of this Court.
