his wife executed a mortgage unto James J. Waeche for the purpose of indemnifying said Waeche should he be required to pay said note the undoned, which said note is unpaid, and the said Waeche will be compelled to pay said note or a greater portion thereof, a Certified Copy of said mortgage being filed herewith marked "Exhibit No."

7 That said Enos Coor became indebted unto a certain George Stimmel during his lifetime in the sum of one hundred and twenty three dollars and eleven cents, for which indebtedness the said Stimmel obtained a judgement dated Jan 30th 1904, a Certified Copy of which is filed herewith marked "Exhibit 1."

8 That the said Enos Coor, likewise became indebted unto Ephraim Bollity in his lifetime and for which said indebtedness the said Ephraim L. Bollity obtained several judgements, dated Jan. 27th. 1904 one for the sum of \$68.79, one for the sum of \$70. one for the sum of \$65 as will appear from Certified Copies filed herewith marked Exhibits to "J. K" and L, respectively.

9. That at the time of the death of the said Enos Coor he left surviving him, a widow whose name is Catherine Coor, a daughter Cassandra Waeche, whose husband's name is James J. Waeche; a grand daughter Mary C Coor, the only child of J. Milton Coor a deceased son, all of whom reside in Frederick County, Maryland, except Mary C. Coor, who resides in Baltimore, Maryland.

And your Complainants pray for the relief:

(A) That the said real estate of the said Enos Coor, deceased, may be sold for the payment of the various liens thereon, and then to the payment of the claim of your Complainant and the other Creditors of said deceased, who may come in and contribute to the expenses of these proceedings.

(B). And for such other and further relief as the nature and Equity of this case may require. And your Complainants pray for the following process:

That the writ of Subpoena in the usual form may be directed to Catherine Coor, Cassandra Waeche and James J. Waeche her husband, James J. Waeche Mortgagee George W. Stimmel Ephraim L. Bollity and James J. Waeche, Administrator and to Mary C. Coor, denoting them and each
