To the Honorable the Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick  
County, sitting as a Court of Equity.

The Petition of George W. Lough and William B. Cutchall  
shown unto your Honor:-

1st- That a certain John Q. Lough late of Frederick  
deceased, died on or about the 1st of March in  
the year A. D. 1901, leaving a last will and testament  
dated October the 12th A. D. 1895, a certified copy of  
which Will is herewith filed and marked Exhibit No. 1.  
to this Bill which together with all other exhibits  
Your Petitioners pray may be taken and considered  
as a fact hereof.

2nd- That the said John Q. Lough left surviving him  
a widow, Mary A. Lough and two children George A. Lough  
and Myrtle Cutchall, the widow Mary A. Lough having  
died on or about the 8th day of August, in the  
year A. D. 1904, and Myrtle C. Cutchall, the  
daughter of testator having died on or about  
the 11th day of April A. D. 1898, intestate,  
leaving surviving her three infant children Mary  
J. Cutchall, Nora M. Cutchall and Gail L. Cutchall  
all children of Petitioner William B. Cutchall  
surviving husband.

3rd- That said Will exhibit No. 1 directs a sale of  
the Real estate of which the testator died seized and  
found, after the death of his widow, Mary A. Lough,  
and the proceeds arising from the sale to be divided  
between his two children share alike, but names no  
one to execute the power of sale.

To the end therefore:-

1st- That Your Honorable Court will some suitable  
person trustee to execute the power of sale provided  
by the said will exhibit No. 1, prescribing the terms  
and conditions of said sale

2nd And for such other and further relief as the  
Nature of the Case may require.
