

## No. 7848 Equity.

Situate in Frederick County, Maryland near the Village of Waetersweel.

The Bill states that Erwin D. Brager died during the month of June in the year A. D. 1903 leaving a last Will and Testament bearing date April 6th A. D. 1895 recorded in Liber L. & S. No. Folio, 456 one of the Record books for the recording of the Wills in the Office of the Register of Wills for Frederick County. That Erwin D. Brager by said will devised to his wife Ellen Amanda Brager, the real estate mentioned in the Will as "Sunny Side" of which he died seized and possessed for and during her natural life, remainder to his daughter Florence Engler during her life remainder to the issue of his her daughter Florence Engler, if any; and in the event of her daughter Florence die without issue, then to his nephew and niece or their heirs equally. The Bill further alleges that her daughter Florence Engler, has since died without issue, whereupon the remainder after <sup>the</sup> death of Complainant testator's wife, vested in the nephew and niece of said testator, of his own blood. Brager adult resident of Philadelphia, Lucetta V. Brager, adult resident of Brownsville Texas, Chas. of Ephraim Brager a deceased brother of Erwin D. Brager Eugene H. Savidge, adult resident of New York Frank R. Savidge and Edgar Savidge Grace Savidge Mrs. Myrtle Savidge, Chas. of Alcinda Savidge deceased daughter of Ephraim Brager, Adults residing in Philadelphia Pa. Grand nephew and niece of said Erwin D. Brager, grand-nephew Charles E. Broadbent, adult residing in Philadelphia Pa. who was a son of Caroline E. Broadbent, a deceased daughter of Ephraim Brager, who died during the year A. D. 1871. And the following children of Martha Radcliff, a deceased sister of Erwin D. Brager, Elizabeth Bowhan, Sarah E. Grubbs, Ida M. Brown, and the unknown children of Thomas Radcliff, a deceased son of Martha Radcliff, who are supposed to reside in the State of Tennessee.
