To the Honorable the Judge of the Circuit Court
 for Frederick County, sitting in Equity:—
 The petition of Perry Looman and Edward L.
 Davis vs Adams, in the above case respectfully
 show unto your Honor,
 That before the sale of the real estate reported
 in the above case was made petitioner Perry
 Looman, procured a judgment against the
 mortgagor Isaac J. Runkler, which was rendered
 before the sale, for the sum of \$44, which with
 costs and interest to date amounts \$44.65,
 which judgment was a lien upon the real
 estate, and entitled to payment from
 the proceeds of sale.
 That before said sale petitioner Edward L.
 Davis, procured two judgments against
 the mortgagor, Isaac J. Runkler aggregating the
 sum of \$84.66, with accrued interest which
 judgments liens upon the mortgagor property
 before the sale of the same, and entitled
 to payment from the proceeds of sale
 according to their priority.
 To the end therefore
 (1) That Your Honor will pass an order direct-
 ing the auditor to allow said judgment
 claims out of the proceeds of sale
 reported in the above case, of ~~set~~ the
 payment of the mortgaged debt, according to
 their priority.
