To the Honorable the Judges of said Court:—  
The Bill of Complaint of the Cazavette Guano Company, of the City of Baltimore a body Corporate, which files this Bill as well for itself as for all other Creditors of Thos A DeLashmuth who may come in and contribute to the expenses of this Suit, respectfully represents unto your Honorable Court:—  
1st. That Thos A DeLashmuth is indebted to the plaintiff by the joint and several promissory note of said Thos A DeLashmuth, dated the first day of November a d 1897 payable Four months after date for Twenty four hundred and fifty four dollars, which note accrued interest amounts (\$992.04), ninety three hundred and ninety two dollars and four Cents, and upon which note various payments have been made aggregating (\$5245.02) fifty two hundred and forty five dollars and two Cents, which credits together with a proper interest allowance aggregate (6412.91) Sixty four and twelve dollars and Ninety one
