17th. Three Small houses situated on the Street, in said
Frederick City, and which were conveyed to said
Lideon Bantz, from George H. Leas and wife,
by deed dated November 17th, 1851 and
recorded in Liber T. S. D. No. 13 folio 589. one of
Land Records of Frederick County aforesaid.

13th. And it is prayed your Honor will take and
consider all Exhibits filed herewith, or that
may be hereafter filed by the Plaintiffs as Exhibits
hereto as a part hereto.

To the end, therefore,

- (1) That a decree may be passed for the sale of
the aforesaid real estate.
- (2) That the proceeds of said Sale, after Costs
and expenses have been paid, may be distributed
to those entitled to receive the same according to
their respective rights and interests.
- (3) That such action may be had as well forever
clear and remove any Cloud if any there be
which may exist, upon the title to the property
described in Paragraph 9th. of this Bill.
- (4) That such action may be had as well
secure to the estate the money due thereon
by virtue of the Mortgage mentioned in
Paragraph 10th. of the Bill, or so much
thereof as may be Collectable, either by
foreclosure proceedings or otherwise.
- (5) That said Plaintiffs may have such
other and further relief as they may
require.

May it please your Honor to grant
unto these Plaintiffs the writ of Subpoena
directed to the said Eugene H. Bantz of
Baltimore City, ^{State of} Maryland, Adult, and
The Frederick Town Savings Institution, a
body Corporate, who's place of business is
located in Frederick County, and State of
Maryland, and William Luther Duvall
and Mary A. Duvall, his wife, of Frederick
City, Frederick County, and State of Maryland
commanding them and each of them to be
and appear in this Court at some ^{day} certain
to be named therein and answer the premises,
and abide by and perform such orders and
decrees as may be passed therein.
