Lot No. 4.

That lot of ground extending from Market Street on the east to an alley on the west, and immediately south and adjoining Lot No. 3, and improved by a three-story brick Dwelling House (6 rooms) and cellar under entire building, and at present in the occupancy of Mr. Arthur Keller. This property was acquired by the said Hideo Banty, as part of the purchase described at Lot No. 3.

Lot No. 5.

That two-story brick, slate roof Dwelling House and premises, with one story slate roof back building, with cellar, situated No. 44, on West all Saints Street Frederick City and being a portion of the real estate conveyed to the said Hideo Banty, from Peter Mautz executor of the last will and testament of Peter Mautz, deceased, by deed dated April 30, 1854, and recorded in Liber C. S. No. 8, folio 64, and 65, one of the Land Records of Frederick County.

Lot No. 6.

That Brick Dwelling House and premises immediately adjoining Lot No. 5, on the West and being similar property, and which was conveyed to the said Hideo Banty by the same deed; these two properties being all that remains of the property there conveyed; one lot upon the east and one upon the west having been heretofore conveyed away during the lifetime of the said Hideo Banty.

Lot No. 7.

The one-story weatherboarded, shingle roof Dwelling House and premises, situated No 100, on the east side of ice Street just south of Mrs. Marshall's ice house, in said Frederick City, and which property, together with lots No. 8, and 9, conveyed to the said Hideo Banty from George H. Lease and wife by deed dated November 17, 1851, and recorded in Liber # 13 S. No. 13, folio 589, one of the Land Records of Frederick County.

Lot No. 8.

That brick one and one-half story shingle roof Dwelling House and premises situated No 102, Ice Street, and immediately adjoining Lot No. 7, on the South. This house has a
