(6.) Your oratrix, Mary E. Wherefore your petitioners pray that a decree may be passed by your Honorable Court ratifying and confirming the sale heretofore mentioned of the interest and estate of the said infants in to the real estate and appointing a trustee to convey said interest and estate of said petitioners by a good and sufficient deed to the purchaser, and that your petitioners may have such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.

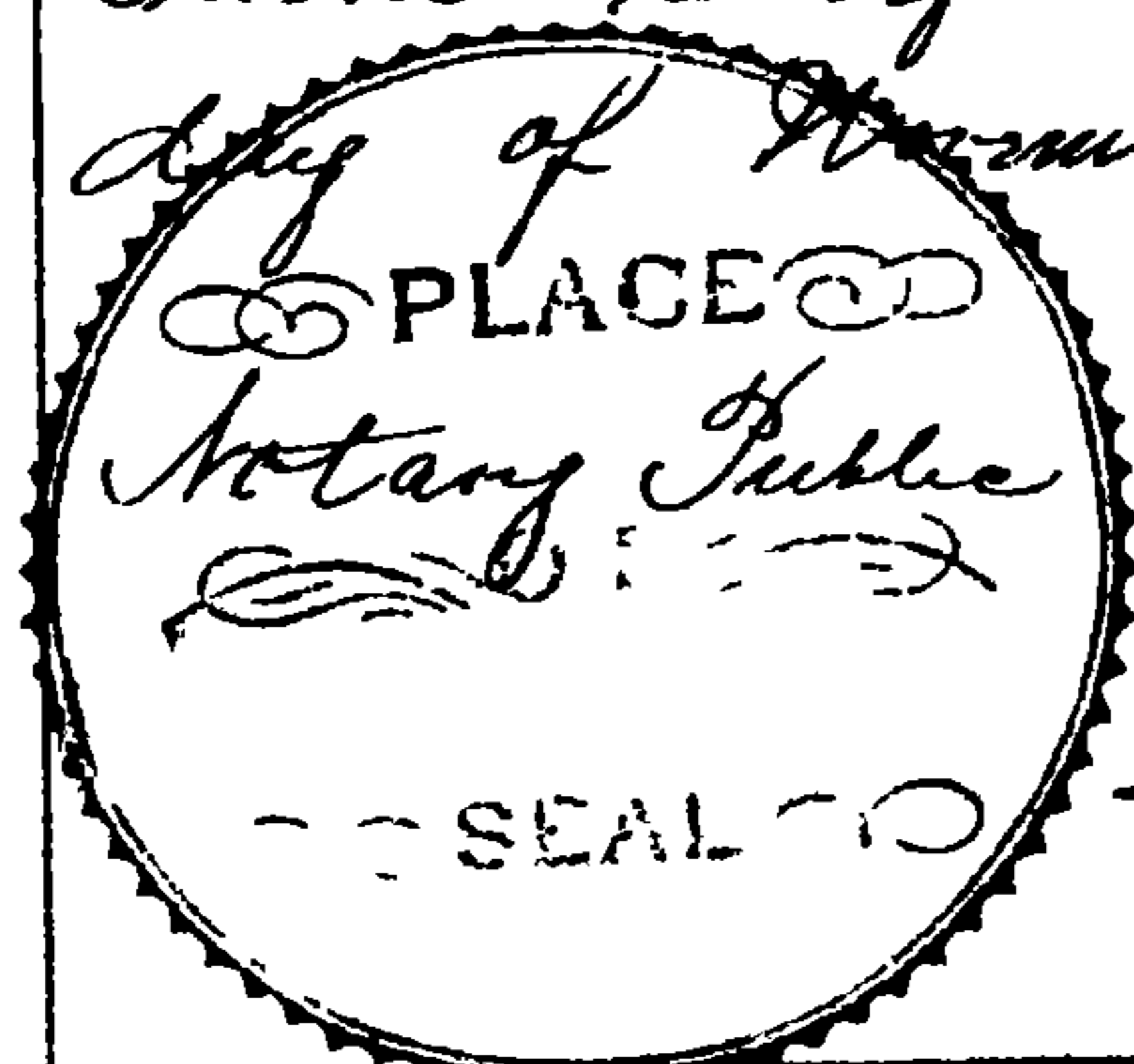
