


At the request of Henry Gordon Strong the following deed is received for record, and recorded Sept 17th 1903. at 11²⁰ O'clock A. M.

This Deed made this sixth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and three by and between Thomas O. White and Annie E. White, his wife and Cordelia A. White widow of Richard G. White (late of Montgomery County, Maryland) of Barnesville Montgomery Co Md. parties of the first part and Henry Gordon Strong of Chicago. Witnesseth that in Consideration of five dollars paid by the party of the second part to the parties of the first part, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said parties of the first part do grant and convey unto the said Henry Gordon Strong party of the second part, his heirs and assigns in fee simple all that piece or parcel of ground situate lying and being in Frederick County, State of Maryland, being the same land which Richard G. White father of the said Thomas O. White obtained from Margaret Taylor, and John Taylor, her husband, by deed, dated the nineteenth day of April A. D. 1869, and recorded in the land records of Frederick County Maryland, in Liber to M No 3 folio 476, and being described as follows, to wit: all that part or parcel of land being in the Sugar Loaf Mountain, "being in two lots called part of Littleworth" being part of the land conveyed by William D. Beare and wife to Otho Riley, beginning for the first lot hereby conveyed at the end of the eighth line of A. D. deed from said William D. Beare and wife, to Otho Riley, dated July 22-1851 and recorded in Liber M 13 D. No. 13, folio 260, one of the land records

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
