Considering the uncertainty of life and being of sound mind and memory do make and declare and publish this my last will and testament.

First. I Give and bequeath to the Children of my Son James L. Wetly, the Sum of One Hundred Dollars to each and every one the same amount.

Second. I give and bequeath to the Children of my daughter Margaret Louisa intermarried with John T. Agnew, (in equal Shares) one third of all my property after the former bequest has been paid and after all debts and expenses have been paid.

Third. I give and bequeath to my Lucinda, intermarried with H. H. Cook, one third of all my property, after the first bequest and all the debts and expenses have been paid out.

Fourth I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Est. intermarried with Rev. H. S. Snyder, one third of all my property, after the first bequest and all debts and expenses have been paid out - this one third to be in Bank Stock in the Gettysburg National Bank now in my possession and to be given at its Market Value.

Fifth I do nominate and appoint Theodore McAllister to be the executor of this my last will and testament.
