

No. 7866 Equity

To the Honorable the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity,

The Bill of Complaint of Benjamin F. Taylor on behalf of himself and of all other Creditors of Sarah A. Snyder, deceased, who may come in and contribute to the expense of the proceedings, respectfully sheweth unto your Honors:-

1st. That Sarah A. Snyder, late of Frederick County, <sup>deceased</sup> departed this life, intestate, on or about the 14th day of December, in the year nineteen hundred and four,

2nd. That the said Sarah A. Snyder died seized and possessed of a lot or parcel of ground situate, lying and being in the town of Woodboro', Frederick County, Maryland, known and designated on the plat of said town as Lot Number Nine (9), and being the same devised to the said Sarah A. Snyder by her Sister Margaret A. E. Snyder, by last will and testament bearing date on the 14th day of April, 1887 said property being the same real estate conveyed unto the said Margaret A. E. Snyder, under the name of Elizabeth Snyder, by Jacob Beard and Mary A. Beard, his wife, by deed dated on the 3rd day of April, 1869 as will fully appear by reference to a Certified Copy of said Will and a Certified Copy of said deed, herewith filed as Exhibits "A" and "B" to this Bill of Complaint, and which, together with all other Exhibits hereinafter proposed, it is prayed may be taken and considered as part hereof.

3rd. That at the time of her death the said Sarah A. Snyder was indebted unto your Complaint in the sum of Twenty Seven hundred and seventy-one dollar and fifty-four Cents, upon open account, an itemized statement of same and of said indebtedness being herewith filed as exhibit "C", which said debt is still due owing and unpaid.

4th. That the personal estate of the said Sarah A. Snyder is wholly insufficient for the payment of her debts, and is of such small amount, and value that no letters of Administration have been taken out upon her estate.

5th. That the said Sarah A. Snyder died intestate, unmarried and without issue, and left surviving her, as your Complaint becometh and charges, the following niece and nephew as her only heirs at law.
