(g) Harrison Royer, a son of the said decedent, who is an infant and resides in Frederick County, Maryland

(3) - That the said John Royer, and Amanda J. Royer, his wife, at and for the sum of \$3000.<sup>00</sup>, on the 26th day June A.D., 1901 conveyed to Samuel M. Beverly, by way of mortgage, the above mention tracts or parcels of land, said mortgage being recorded in Liber No. 144, (D No. No.) folios 46 et seq, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland a duly Certified Copy of said mortgage being herewith filed and marked Exhibit "B", and asked to be taken as part hereof

4.- That the said real estate will not admit of being divided among the parties entitled thereto without loss and injury to the said parties

To the end Therefore

(1) That a decree may be passed for the sale of the said real estate,

(2) That the proceeds of said sale after the payment of the Costs attending such sale may be distributed to the respective parties entitled thereto according to their respective rights and interests;

(3) That your Complainant may have such other and further and more general relief as his Case may require or to Equity appertains.

Beverly, Administratrix and Stanley M. Fryor, all Adults, and Alta M. Brown, Anna E. Fryor, and Harrison Royer Infants and all residing in Frederick County Maryland, and an order of publication giving notice to Samuel J. Royer, an Adult who is a non-resident of the State of Maryland of the object and substance of this bill, and warning him to be and appear in this Court on or before a certain day to be named therein, in person or by Solicitor, to show Cause, if any they have why a decree ought not to be passed as prayed herein
