The above cause standing ready for a hearing, and being submitted, the Bill, answer, Exhibits and evidence and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered. It is thereupon, this 18<sup>th</sup> day of May, in the year nineteen hundred and five by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, and by the authority of said Court, adjudged, ordered, and decreed, that the land and premises mentioned in these proceedings be sold, and that Joseph W. Wolfinger, Circuit Clerk, and D. Prichard Buckley, of Frederick County, be, and they are hereby appointed Trustees, to make the said sale, and that the time and manner of their proceedings shall be as follows: they shall first file in the Clerk's office of this Court, a bond to the State of Maryland, executed by them with a surety or sureties, to be approved by the Court, or the Clerk thereof, in the penalty of nine thousand Dollars, conditioned for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in them by this decree, or which may be reposed in them by any future order, or decree in the premises they shall then proceed to make sale of the said Real Estate, having first given at least three weeks previous notice, inserted in some newspaper printed in Frederick County, and such other notice as
