in the State of Maryland respectfully represents unto
your Honor.

1st

That on the first day of June in the
year 1887 there was conveyed by deed by John B.
Thomas as Trustee in in 5227 Equity in the
Circuit Court for Frederick County Sitting as a Court
of Equity to the Plaintiff, Mary L. Michael and
her two sisters, Martha W. P. Banckew and Margaret
L. Custard, as tenants in common certain real estate on
the North Side of West Patrick Street in Frederick City, Frederick
County Maryland, consisting of a lot of ground with
improvements thereon a certified copy of which deed
is recorded among the Land Records of Frederick of
Frederick County as filed herewith marked Exhibit No. 1,
which Exhibit together with such other Exhibits, as the
Plaintiffs may file herewith, it is prayed may be taken
and considered as a part of this bill as fully as
if herein at large set forth.

2nd

That they never parted with the title deeds
and which so being seized and possessed as tenants
in common on the Twenty seventh day of April in
the year Eighteen hundred ninety three the said Marg-
aret L. Custard departed this life intestate.

3rd

That the said Margaret L. Custard never married
in her lifetime and she died without leaving any children
