The Bill of Complaint of Joseph N. Hoays,
Committee of Annie Smith under proceedings
in Equity Cause No. 4158 Equity, on the Equity docket
of your Honorable Court, represents respectfully unto
your Honor -

1st That your Complainant is an adult and a resident
of Frederick County, Maryland. that the defendant is
an adult and a resident of Heidelberg, Adams
County, Pennsylvania.

2nd. That on the 27th. day of March, A. D. 1900.
Lunacy proceedings were instituted in your Honorable
Court and Commission issued to Charles F. Truitt, then
Sheriff of said Frederick County to inquire into the lunacy
of one Annie Smith a resident of said Frederick County. that
in pursuance of said Authority, an inquisition was held in
due form and in compliance with law on the 28th. day
of March following and the finding under said inquisition
was that said Annie Smith was of sound mind, not
capable of the government of herself or the management of her
estate, and on the 6th. day of April A. D. 1900. your Honorable
Court passed an order ratifying and confirming said in-
quisition and appointing your Complainant the Com-
mittee of said Annie Smith both of her person
and estate to bond in the sum of twenty-five
hundred dollars, (\$2500 00) for the faithful
performance of the trust reposed in him by said
order or decree, of which will appear by reference
