Something near four years, at the rate of one hundred and fifty dollars per annum as provided in said Court's Order, said sum being the amount paid by Frederick County to January 1st 1905, for and on account of said Annie Smith.

D. 1901 in No 7158 Equity on the Equity Docket of said Court, that Joseph H. Kaye, Committee of Annie Smith duly appointed as such in the proceedings in said Cause, of Frederick County Maryland pay to the Clerk of the Board for us and on our behalf, the Sum of Five hundred and forty-eight dollars and thirty-seven Cents being the amount due and unpaid for the support of said Annie Smith in the Springfield State Hospital for the Income of the State of Maryland to January 1st 1905. Something nearly four years, at the rate of one hundred and fifty dollars per annum as provided in said Court's Order said sum being the amount paid by Frederick County to January 1st, 1905 for and on account of said Annie Smith.
