The Bill of Complaint of Gertrude Woodward, formerly Gertrude
Roles and Cornelius Woodward her husband of Frederick
County, and State of Maryland respectfully shows
unto your Honors -

1st- That a certain Eliza Ann. Roles was in her
lifetime seized, and possessed of a dwelling house
and lot of ground situate and being on the
West Side of Ice Street in the City of Frederick,
Frederick County and State of Maryland, it
being the same lot or parcel of land described
in the deed from Jacob Reaser to Jonathan Murdock
ack dated August 25-1832 and recorded in
Liber J P No. 39 folio 535 one of the land recor-
ds of Frederick County which the said Eliza Ann
Roles inherited from the said Jonathan Murdock,
the father of the said Eliza Ann. Roles.

2nd - That the said Eliza Ann. Roles being so seized
and possessed of the said dwelling house and
lot aforesaid departed this life sometime in
the month of a. d. 1889 leaving a last will and
Testament in and by which, among other things she
devised as follows: "I give and devise my house
and lot situated on the West side of Ice Street in
Frederick City, Maryland, fronting on said Street
twenty-six feet and adjoining the property of Frank
Roberts on the North and my other property on said
Street on the South, and being the same property
that was conveyed to my Father Jonathan Murdock
by Jacob Reaser by deed dated August 25, 1832 and
recorded in Liber J P No 39 folio 535 &c one of the Land
Records of Frederick County, and which said property I
inherited from my said Father, to my daughter Gertrude Ann.
