3. That at the time of the death of the said John W. Brandenburg he left surviving him a widow Sarah W. Brandenburg, who has since died having departed this life at said Frederick County, Maryland, May A.D. 1904.

4. That the said John W. Brandenburg died at said County intestate, leaving surviving him the following children as heirs at law, and all now living Samuel C. Brandenburg a son whose wife's name is Laura W. Brandenburg, plaintiffs in this Cause, Margella E. Castle, a daughter whose husband's name is Joseph E. Castle Alice C. Coline, a daughter whose husband's name is Charles L. Coline; Glenn Ora E. Alexander a daughter whose husband's name is George F. Alexander; Mary L. Summers, a daughter whose husband's name is William H. Summers; George W. Brandenburg, a son whose wife's name is Fannie W. Brandenburg, John W. Brandenburg, a son whose wife's name is Ida Brandenburg; Charles W. Brandenburg a son whose wife's name is Mary J. Brandenburg; Thomas H. Brandenburg; a son whose wife's name is Mary L. Brandenburg; and Sarah A. Gann, a daughter whose husband is James L. Gann.

5. That the above named children, heirs at law of the said John W. Brandenburg are owners of the property described in said exhibit A, and are unable to agree among themselves as to a disposition of the property.

6. That the said real estate is not susceptible of a division among the above mentioned owners and that it cannot be divided without great loss and injury, but that it would be to the interest and advantage of all of said parties to have the same sold and the proceeds arising therefrom after the payment of all costs, charges and expenses, divided among them according to their respective interests.

And the Plaintiffs pray for the following relief:

First, That a decree may be passed directing said real estate to be sold and the proceeds to be divided among the respective owners thereof.

Second, That a summons may be issued directed to the said Margella E. Castle, Joseph E. Castle, Alice C. Coline, Charles L. Coline, Glenn Ora E. Alexander, George F. Alexander, Mary L. Summers, William H. Summers, George W. Brandenburg and Fannie W. Brandenburg, all of which of said Frederick County in order that they may answer the matters and things herein stated commanding them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some certain day to be named therein.
