Your orator, who sues as well for herself as for
all other Creditors of John W. Stottmeyer, late of Frederick
County deceased, who will come in and contribute to
the expense of this suit, humbly Complaining, Says:

life time and at the time of his death, indebted
unto your oratrix, Mary E. Palmer, upon a certain
promissory note for the sum of one hundred and twenty-
five dollars, dated April 28, 1897, payable one year after
date to the said Mary E. Palmer, your oratrix, made
evidently written Ella W. Palmer in said note, with
interest at the rate of Four and one-half per centum
per annum from the date of said note, upon which
note the interest has been paid up April 1, 1901;
and also unto your orator upon a certain single
bill for the sum of Two hundred dollars, dated
January 27th, 1899, payable one year after date
to your oratrix, written in said bill Mary Edna
Palmer, without interest, as well fully appear by refer-
ence to said promissory note and single bill,
herewith filed as part thereof, marked respec-
tively "Exhibit A & B, which, together with all other
Exhibits herewith filed as part thereof, marked respectively

filed, are prayed to be taken and considered as a part
of this Bill of Complaint.
