The Petition of Gleam N. Worthington and Julia A.  
Worthington, the Plaintiffs in the above entitled Cause  
respectfully represent that:-

1. The Savings Bank of Brunswick, a body Corporate,  
holds a magistrate's judgment of Record in the  
office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Frederick County,  
date May 29, 1905, for the sum of \$57.75 and Costs,  
against William P. Carey and Minnie Carey, his  
wife two of the defendants named in the Bill of  
Complaint filed in the above Cause, the same  
being recorded in Liber No. 6, at page 26, Magistrate trans-  
cript booklet as on 96.

2. That said judgment by reason of its being recorded  
in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court, as afore-  
said, is a lien on any interest which the said William  
P. Carey and wife may have in the land and  
premises mentioned in the Bill of Complaint but  
that the said Bank was inadvertently omitted as a  
party defendant, to said Bill, as will appear by  
reference thereto.

Your petitioners therefore pray your Honor  
to pass an order authorizing a summons to issue  
for said Saving Bank of Brunswick that it may  
appear and answer the said Bill and abide by  
such decree as may be passed in the premises  
as if made a party defendant in the first  
instance, in accordance with the Act of 1892,  
Chapter 654 Codified in the Code of 1904 as Article  
16, Sec 200.
