 And, That the said Elizabeth Green died intestate some years ago, leaving surviving her a husband Michael Green William Green ^{Benjamin Green}, George Green and Jennie Green his wife, Samuel Green and Margaret Green, his wife, Silphman Holmer, Effie McPhee and Nathaniel McPhee her husband Adults of Frederick County, Maryland and Anna Paterson and James McLelland Paterson Adults of Pennsylvania, and Alfred Wolf and Amanda Wolf his wife, adults of Illinois, William Early (Adult) and Helia Early, his wife (infant) Ada C. H. W. Early and Joseph Early her husband infants of Frederick County, Maryland to whom said land descended as heirs at law.

3rd:

That the real estate above described of which the said Elizabeth Green died seized and possessed descended to and vested in the aforesaid parties as tenants in common, and that said real estate is not susceptible of partition amongst the parties without great loss, damage and injury to them and it would be to the best interest of all the parties concerned and especially of the infant heirs to have the said real estate sold under a decree of this Honorable Court and the proceeds divided among or invested for the benefit of the parties entitled thereto according to their respective interest and rights.
