should be made parties to this suit.

That Catherine A. Rogers has three
Adult Children to wit, the said James W. Wolfe,
Augustus A. H. Wolfe and William S. Rogers who are
parties to this suit.

That said Catherine A. Rodgers is
entitled under the said will to an undivided
third life interest in said property, and at her
death the same goes in her Children, and des-
cendants then living.

That Elizabeth F. Webb is entitled to
receive during her life under a deed to F. Hoack trustee
from F. Hoack one third of the revenue from said
property and at her death the same goes in her

provided in said will.
