The Report of sale of Frederick A. Mack Trustee appointed by the decree in the above entitled Case to make sale of the farm and Mountain Lot referred to in the Petition filed Nov 27th 1897, in the proceedings in said Case mentioned respectfully shows that after giving bond with security for the faithful discharge of his trust as prescribed by said decree, which was duly approved, sold at private sale the "property described in the deed filed with said Petition as Exhibit No. 1, to wit a deed from Lewis Motter and wife to Mrs. C. Mack et al. Trustee which is recorded in Liber A. F. No 11. Folio 350 re. of the land records of Frederick County, Maryland, to James B. Elder, for the sum of four thousand four hundred dollars Cash, to be paid upon the ratification of said sale property being described as follows "all those two tracts of land lying and being in Frederick Staumbaugh and Margaret Staumbaugh his wife to Mary Ann Jones dated April 2nd 1880, and recorded among the Land Records of Frederick Co. in Liber A.
