To the Honorable the Judge of said Court,
The petition of vs. Felix Adams, Nora A. Adams
and Etta Adams, the plaintiffs in this case
respectfully represents.

1st that by inadvertence your petitioners alleged
in the fifth paragraph of their bill of Complaint
in this cause that the sum of money as well
as the horse and buggy therein mentioned were
an indebtedness of the said Joseph H. Adams
to the Estate of Anne M. Adams whilst in
fact they were not indebtedness at all.

2. That your petitioners desire by leave of your
Honorable Court to amend the said fifth paragraph
of said bill by striking out therefrom the following
words to wit: "is indebted to the estate of said
Anne M. Adams in" and by interlining in lieu
thereof of the following words to wit "has been advanced"

3. That said amendment if made will not
materially vary the general structure of the said
case, as to the defendants therein except possibly
George L. Gillelaw, Virginia Gillelaw, administrators of
said S. Gillelaw and William A. Kempf,

And your petitioners would therefore pray your
Honors to grant unto them leave to amend said
fifth paragraph of said bill by striking out the
following words, to wit "indebted to the Estate of
said Anne M. Adams in" and interlining in
lieu thereof the following words, to wit "has been
advanced" and also to grant them leave to withdraw
the general replication already filed,
