She is dead she died about the year 1888. She died intestate. I was the administrator of the personal estate, (Last sentence open to) at the time of said Mrs Annie M Adams death there was \$500= due on the principal of said mortgage with interest. The interest was paid regularly every year. The next year after her death her son came to me and asked when the interest would be due, and I told them, and they came to me and paid the interest for one year. The son paid the interest up to April 6, 1905. During her life time she and her husband had paid to me \$1500= on the principal of said mortgage.

Quest

Look at the paper now shown you marked Exhibit C, D, and state what the same is?

Ans

It is ^{one of} the mortgage note belonging to said mortgage. It is signed by John F. Adams and Annie M. Adams, his wife.

I indorsed all of the credits on the back of said note.

Question:

Did Annie M Adams during her life-time pay you any other sum of money of attorney? if yes, what for? (Except to)

Ans.

She did for a note for some money which I loaned her son, on which she was security. I look at Exhibit C & D No. 2, and that is the note of which I speak (Except to) this last mentioned note was signed by Joseph M Adams (her son) and the said Anna F. Adams (Except to).

Her son Joseph borrowed the money mentioned in said note and his mother went on as security or she would not have got the money (Except to)

Said last mentioned note is paid. It was paid by Mrs. Adams (the mother of Joseph M.) (Except to)

They paid me the whole of said note and interest in March 1902, except one year interest of \$18.00 which they refused to pay because the note did not call for interest from date. That was the reason for not paying it. (Exhibit C).

Ans

Whom do you mean by they? (Except to) I meant Mrs. Adams paid it. Ed Rowe came there with her when she paid it, and that is the reason why I said they (Except to).

Question

State whether or not Joseph M Adams was present when said payment was made (Except to as leading & General)

Ans

He was not there.
